CITATION (Date and place of action must be stated):

For outstanding courage, frequently beyond the call of duty on the following dates -

- (a) 18 July 1944
- (b) 24 July 1944
- (c) 27 August 1944

(a) At Puna Puna Village, New Britain, lead a successful assault on the enemy and showed great determination and ability.

(b) Prior to an attack by AIB Guerillas on a strong defensive position at Rang, New Britain voluntarily made a preliminary reconnaissance of enemy territory, later leading a section to the rear. During a four hour attack which followed, Maramun exhibited high qualities of leadership and with great courage, boldly advanced and forced the enemy position with grenades. He contributed largely to the defeat of the enemy.

(c) At Kagal Village, New Britain while commanding 2 guerilla sections successfully employed hand grenades in an attack and showed great initiative, thereby causing the defeat of an enemy party.
